

## ENG 111-112

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The aim of this course is to familiarize students with the language needed to communicate in non-routine and/or emergency situations during flight operations. Also, the course aims to increase students' confidence in communication and develops specific skills described in the ICAO Language Proficiency Requirements.

### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

Specifically, students are expected to

- ❖ Recognize non-routine/emergency situations in aviation
- ❖ Understand the messages during a non-routine/emergency situation
- ❖ Respond appropriately during a non-routine/emergency situation
- ❖ Communicate using appropriate aviation terms

### **COURSE OUTCOMES**

At the end of the course, students will be able to

- ❖ Understand aviation related texts/passages
- ❖ Recognize and use the appropriate pronunciation of essential vocabulary in aviation
- ❖ Recognize voice-only communication between pilots and between pilots-ATCs.
- ❖ Have conversations in aviation topics
- ❖ Use plain English in an operational context
- ❖ Use functional English to deal with the non-standard, abnormal and emergency situations
