		IN CLASS SPOKEN ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
(6-5)	Consistently	Uses spoken English at every possible opportunity and actively encourages fellow students to do so. Uses L1 only when it does not detract from completion of the task in hand or distract other students. Initiates, responds and develops the interaction and reacts positively to any very occasional prompting to use spoken English.
(4-3)	Usually	Uses spoken English whenever directed to do so by the teacher or by the task in hand and is willing to interact with fellow students in pair and group work, initiating and responding. May use L1 when searching for words or seeking clarification of instructions and explanations but this does not interfere with the learning of others.
(2-1)	Sometimes	Uses spoken English to a limited extent when directed by the teacher but seldom initiates and produces only very limited responses. Excessive use of L1 impedes the learning of others.
0		Contributes too little Spoken English for valid assessment. Uses L1 to such an extent that this seriously impedes the learning of others. Even when prompted, does not use spoken English to interact with fellow students.


